CALL TO ORDER: Trish Zannelli called this meeting to order at 7:40pm

SECRETARY REPORT: Minutes for the previous month's meeting were typed and submitted for approval on May 3rd, 2010. Minutes were approved by President Tom McKay and posted.

COMMUNICATION REPORT: Tracy McMahon has nothing current to report.

TREASURER REPORT: Bill Geary reports the month ending April 2010, still shows a positive balance of \$2,536.34 in the General Fund.

Disbursements have been made to cover costs incurred for the Bunny Breakfast, October 2009 Car Raffle, Winterguard Show, Jazz Showcase, Flower Sale, Drum-a-Thon, Marching Griffin uniform & costume maintenance, senior plume purchase and concert band audition judges, totalling \$24,454.00.

Jazz Showcase:

Tammy Cantu is the new chairperson for this fundraiser. She will be meeting with Booster parents on Thursday, who will be soliciting SIAM card vendors. Tom McKay has secured 3 new vendors for the card. Sale dates will be: Sun. Aug. 22nd & Sun. Aug. 29th. Drivers are needed.

Flower Sale:

Delivery of flowers will be on Friday May 7th between 8-8:30am on the north side of the school, by the tennis courts. Karen Lezon will be at that location for flower pick up from 3:30-7:30 on that same day. A few extras have been ordered.

Car Wash: Maribeth Meaux is chairing this event, which will be held on Sat. June 26th at LWE h/s only.

First Midwest Amphitheatre: DJ Wells will be chairing this event, with Kim Bennett shadowing. There are 23 shows on the calendar this year with the first show being May 22nd. A new pay format is in place, in that each shift will be paid \$75.00/shift. If Boosters work ALL shows, a 1% bonus will be paid to the General Fund.
